

How many items can I take out at one time from the main collection?

- You may borrow up to six books at a time for 21 days each, renewable twice, either in person or online at www.qnl.qa
- DVD sets, CD-ROMs and kits can be borrowed for up to 14 days each, nonrenewable


Are there penalties for overdue or lost books?


For books, after 60 days from the due date you will be charged 100 QR per item and your account will be suspended. For CDs, DVDs and kits, you will be charged 20 QR per item per day after the due date.


If you lose or badly damage an item, you'll have to pay double the price of a new one, plus a 50 QR processing fee.

Can children and young adults check out books from the main collection?

You have to be 18 or over to check out books from the main collection. Parents can check out books from the main collection on their own card for their children at their own discretion.

What if I can't find the book or item I'm looking for?

If you can't find what you're looking for in the catalog or our online resources, you may request an item through our Interlending and Document Supply Service. Visit www. qnl.qa or stop by the User Services Desk to find out more. Can adults access the Children's and Young Adults' Library?

Yes, adults are free to check out items from the Children's and Young Adults' Library with their membership cards.

How do I find the book I want?

You can search our online catalog at www.qnl.qa or use one of the many tablets and computers throughout the Library. Note the book's call number—which you can find on its spine—and use the online map to find its location. You can also ask our staff at the Information Desk for help.

Where can I park?

There are two car parks across the road from the Library, as well as valet parking. You can also leave your vehicle at either the Oxygen Park's underground car park or the Education City Mosque parking lots and take the free Education City tram to the Multaqa (Student Center) station, which also serves the Library.
