How many items can I take out at one time from the main collection?

- You may borrow up to four books at a time for 21 days each, renewable twice, either in person or online at www.qnl.qa
- DVD sets, CD-ROMs and kits can be borrowed for up to 14 days each, non-renewable

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



Are there penalties for overdue or lost books?

There is no fine for overdue books, although your account will be suspended until the book is renewed or returned. DVD sets, CD-ROMs and kits have a fine of 20 QR per item, per day. If you lose or badly damage an item, you'll have to pay for a new one, plus a 50 QR processing fee. The forgetful type? Don't worry—we'll send you courtesy emails to remind you when your items are due.



How do I find the book I want?

You can search our online catalog at www.qnl.qa or use one of the many tablets and computers throughout the Library. Note the book's call number—which you can find on its spine—and use the online map to find its location. You can also ask our staff at the Information Desk for help.

What if I can't find the book or item I'm looking for?

If you can't find what you're looking for in the catalog or our online resources, you may request an item through our Interlending and Document Supply Service. Visit www.qnl.qa or stop by the User Services Desk to find out more.

Can adults access the Children's and Young Adults' Library?

Yes, adults are free to check out items from the Children's and Young Adults' Library with their membership cards.

Can young adults check out books from the main collection?

You have to be 18 or over to check out books from the main collection. Parents can check out books from the main collection on their own card for their children at their own discretion.

Where can I park?

There are two car parks across the road from the Library, as well as valet parking. There is also parking available in the Ceremonial Court lot, with shuttle service to the Library provided free of charge.
